Description

This is a two story frame house with some Queen Anne influences. The gable-hip roof is covered with galvanized metal. It is a two bay structure with one over one windows. In the front projecting gable there is a Palladian window. Across the front is a rebuilt wrap-around porch. The exterior is covered with aluminum siding and the foundation is stone. There is a two story garage on the property. This house appears on the 1908 Sanborn map, and reflects residential construction during Hancock's major growth phase.
