Description

This is a two story L-shaped frame house with a gable roof covered with asphalt shingles. It is a three bay structure with one over one windows. There is a porch across the front that has been altered. The exterior siding is aluminum and the foundation is rubble stone. This house appears on the 1908 Sanborn map, and reflects construction patterns of the turn-of-the-century when Hancock experienced its major growth thrust.
