Description

This is a one-and-a-half story brick and shingled Bungalow with a gable-shed roof which is covered with asphalt shingles. It is a three bay structure with paired one over one windows. Across the front is a porch with original battered posts, and across the rear is another porch. With most of it's original exterior features intact, this house represents Hancock's growth phase of the early 20th century.
