Description

This is a two story aluminum sided brick house with a gable roof covered with asphalt shingles. It is a two bay structure with new six over six windows. There is a porch across the front. This house appears on the 1908 Sanborn map, and was built by Hancock contractor Albert Carr. Although greatly altered, it represents Hancock's early 20th century construction boom.
