Description

This is a two story, three bay frame house. The gable roof is covered with standing seam metal. It has two over two windows. Across the front is a porch with original balustrades, turned post and gingerbread treatment. The exterior is covered with asbestos siding and the foundation is rubble stone. There is a small storage shed outbuilding on the property. This house appears on the 1908 Sanborn map, and is among the older houses on this street.
