Description

The Hancock Community Center, a former school, is a three story brick building with a built-up flat roof system. It is a multiple bay structure with replaced commercial fixed windows. The foundation is poured concrete. This building appears on the 1908 Sanborn map, and is significant for its role in local education and reflects the population growth of the early 20th century.
