Description

This is a two story Bungaloid frame house with a gable-shed roof covered with sheet metal. It is a three bay structure with one over one windows. There is a rebuilt porch across the front with a second floor enclosed porch above. The exterior is covered with asbestos siding and the foundation is concrete block. There is a garage on the property. It reflects early 20th century construction patterns in Hancock.
