Description

This is a one story frame house with a gable-shed roof covered with asphalt shingles. It is a four bay structure with three over one windows. Across the front is a porch with some original details. The exterior is covered with German siding and the house has a concrete block foundation. There is a built-in garage at the basement level. It is typical of modest frame construction of Hancock's major growth period.
