Description

This is a one story frame house with a gable-shed roof covered with asphalt shingles. It is a three bay structure with three over one window panes. Across the front is a porch. Sitting on a rubble stone foundation the house is covered with asbestos siding. It is typical of modest frame construction during Hancock's major growth period.
