Description

This is a one-and-a-half story frame Bungalow with a gable roof and a front shed dormer which are both covered with asphalt shingles. It is a two bay structure with one over one windows. Across the front and rear are rebuilt porches. The house is covered with aluminum siding. Although altered, it represents residential construction from Hancock's major growth phase.
