Description

This is a two story frame Dutch Colonial house with a Gambrel roof covered with metal standing seam. It is a three bay structure with paired one over one windows. Across the front is a porch. The exterior is covered with asbestos siding and the foundation is concretet block. There are two frame outbuilding, storage or workshop type structures, on the property. It is typical of the late phase of Hancock's major growth period.
