Description

This is a one-and-a-half story frame house with a gable roof and front gable dormer covered with asphalt shingles. It is a three bay structure with three over one windows. Across the front is a new treated lumber deck. Sitting on a rubble stone foundation the house is covered with aluminum siding. It represents the later phase of Hancock's major development period of the early 20th century.
