Description

This is a two story frame house with a gable roof covered with asphalt shingles. It is a three bay structure with one over one and two over two windows. There is a small front porch and a side addition. Sitting on a rubble stone foundation the house is covered with aluminum siding. Although altered, it represents residential construction of Hancock's major growth phase.
