Description

This is a one story frame structure with a gable shed roof covered with asphalt shingles. It is a five bay structure with one over one glass slider windows. The exterior is covered with cedar siding and the foundation is concrete block. There is a small garage on the property. It represents modest frame architecture of Hancock's early 20th century growth phase.
