This is a two story frame church with a gable roof covered with corrugated steel. It is a two bay structure with three over one windows. The exterior is covered with asbestos siding and the foundation is concrete block. There is a square crenelated tower also covered with asbestos shingles. It represents the later phase of Hancock's major growth period.
