Description

This is a two story frame house with Queen Anne influences. The intersecting gable roofs are covered with metal standing seam. It is a five bay structure with one over one windows. The gables are embellished with Gothic windows. Across the front is a wrap-around porch with the original columns. The exterior is covered with narrow guage siding and the foundation is rubble stone. There is a very large early addition of the back side of the house. It represents middle class frame architecture at the beginning of Hancock's major growth period.
