Description

This is a two story Bungalow with a gable-shed roof with shed dormers across the front and rear which are covered with asphalt shingles. It is a three bay structure with six over six windows. Across the front and rear are porches with battered posts on piers. The exterior walls are constructed of clay tile and upper dormers have aluminum siding. The foundation is concrete block and there is a one stall garage on the property. The house is representative of the later phase of Hancock's major growth period of the early 20th century.
