Description

This is a one-and-a-half story frame Bungalow. The gable roof and shed dormers are covered with asphalt shingles. It is a two bay structure with one over one windows. Across the front is a porch with the original details. The exterior is covered with asbestos siding and the foundation is concrete block. There is a one stall block garage on the property. The house is representative of the later phase of Hancock's major growth period of the early 20th century.
