Description

This is a one-and-a-half story frame Bungaloid house. The gable-shed roof and shed dormers have been covered with asphalt shingles. It is a three bay structure with three over one windows. The exterior is covered with aluminum siding and the foundation is concrete block. There is a detached garage on the property. It is representative of the later phase of Hancock's major growth period.
