Description

This is a two story Colonial Revival stone house with a gable roof punctuated by two gable dormers on the front side of the house which are covered with asphalt shingles. It is a three bay structure with six over six windows. The front portico is original with its pilasters and pediments. The walls are laid up with rough cut stones with segmental arches above the windows. The foundation is stone and there is a garage on the property.
