DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Huyett School is located along the north side of Chewsville Road about 1/4 mile west of Maryland Route 66 in Washington County. It is situated on a rise of ground and faces east.

The structure is a five-bay, one-story stone school building, now used as a dwelling. It is coated with white stucco or "rough cast" with white trim.

The windows are placed in the walls with some degree of regularity. Six-over-six pane double-hung sashes are held within narrow frames. A full-size opening is located at the attic level within the gable.

The main entrance is located in the second bay from the north end of the front or east elevation. It is treated very simply with framing similar to the windows.

A three-bay shed roof porch extends along a portion of the entrance wall.

The roof is covered with channel groove sheet metal and extends for several inches beyond the end walls of the house. The eaves are finished with plain boxing. A brick chimney rises from inside the north end of the building. A small modern flue rises from the interior of the structure, south of its center.

The building is in good condition and stands on a tract containing 126.1 acres. The property also contains a stone and log dwelling house and numerous early out buildings which are considered in form WA-I-038.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Huyett School House is significant for its architecture and for its contribution to early education in Washington County. It is thus important also for social-humanitarian concerns.

Architecturally, the building is worthy of note as an example of an early vernacular building constructed for use as a school. Although its exact age has not been determined, it is shown on an 1859 map of Washington County and is said by local historians to have been standing early in the 19th century.

The school house stands on a tract of land called "Huyett's Meadows" which was granted to Ludwick Huyett who was born in 1739. The property remained in the Huyett Family until 1912.


