DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (If known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This house is located just east of Waltz Road, south of the Western Maryland Railroad and north of Maryland Route 64, near Chewsville in Washington County, Maryland. It is situated on level ground and faces south.

The structure is a one and a half story, three bay brick dwelling, with a one and a half story, one bay weatherboarded el extending to the rear or north. The walls, laid in common bond, rest on low fieldstone foundations. Decorative work associated with the walls includes flat arches over main story windows.

Windows appear to be spaced evenly at the front elevation. Those at the lower story have two over two pane double hung sashes held within narrow frames. Upper story windows at the front elevation have pairs of four pane horizontal sashes.

The main entrance is located in the center bay of the front elevation. It is very plain in appearance and does not include a transom.

A one story flat roofed porch extends along the front elevation. It is supported by ring turned square posts with heavily carved decorative brackets.

The roof extends well beyond the end walls and is covered with modern asphalt shingles. Carved gingerbread is present at the barge and eaves areas.

The house appears to be in excellent condition. It stands on a 13 acre tract.


