DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE	
<p>This house is located just east of Mt. Lena Road south of its intersection of Jugtown Road at Judtown in Washington County, Md. It is situated on the west slope of South Mountain and faces west.</p> <p>The structure is a two-bay, one-story log cabin which shows evidence of having been white washed. The walls are set on low fieldstone foundations and are constructed of squared hand hewn logs with square joining at the corners showing no notching. Wood chips and earth mortar chink the logs.</p> <p>Openings have narrow framing with plain trim. Six-over-six light double-hung sashes are present. The main entrance has a four-panel door, two of its panels having been replaced with glass.</p> <p>The roofing material is corrugated sheet metal which terminates at the eaves without boxing or finishing.</p> <p>A shed roofed porch extends along the front elevation. A lean-to addition of frame is attached to the east elevation.</p> <p>The structure is in fair conditon and stands on a tract containing 3.33 acres.</p>

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The area of significance of this house is its architecture. It is a rather late example of a log dwelling and illustrated the persistence of earlier building traditions. Although the structure does not employ the "V" norched corner joining usually found in earlier log buildings, it is a cabin quite primitive for its apparent late 19th century building date. Several log structures of this type are located in Jugtown.


