DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE	
<p>This house is located a short distance east of Mt. Leap Road on the south side of Jugtown Road at Jugtown, Washington County, Md.</p> <p>The structure is a three-bay, one-and-a-half story brick dwelling with white trim. The walls are set on low foundations with bricks laid in common bond at all elevations. Four to six courses of stretcher bricks are present between rows of headers.</p> <p>Windows appear to be placed evenly in the walls. At the main story six-over-six pane double-hung sashes are held within narrow frames with a beaded edge. Wide wooden lintels topped with flat brick arches one-half brick in height are present over all main story openings.</p> <p>Sheet metal covers a roof structure which extends beyond the end walls of the house. Small brick chimneys are located inside each gable end.</p> <p>A shed roof porch is located at the rear or south elevation.</p> <p>The house is in fair to good condition and stands on a tract containing 3.25 acres.</p>

<p>The area of significance of this structure is its architecture. Constructed of brick this small house is an example of a modest dwelling from the second half of the 19th century in Washington County.</p> <p>The village of Jugtown is said to have been named for the presence of several moonshine operations earlier in the 20th century.</p>


