DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE	
<p>This house is located on the east bank of the Antietam Creek at the village of Security or Fiddlersburg, about two miles east of Hagerstown in Washington County, Maryland. It is situated on sloping ground above the Creek's edge and faces west.</p> <p>The structure is a three-bay, one-and-a-half story brick dwelling painted red with white trim. The foundations of rubble fieldstone are quite high at the west and south elevations. A door and window opening for the ground story are set in the foundations.</p> <p>The bricks are laid in common bond at all elevations. No decorative brickwork is apparent at the openings. However, brick corbeling is present at the cornice of the east and west elevations.</p> <p>The windows are simple in appearance, some having wide wooden lintels and sills. All have narrow jambs finished with a beaded edge. The main entrance is located in the south bay of the west elevation. It is similar in appearance to the windows and contains no transom.</p> <p>A two-bay entrance porch protects the entrance at the ground and main story levels. The roof is covered with corrugated sheet metal which terminates with a plain barge set directly against the end walls. A brick chimney is located inside the south gable end.</p> <p>The house is in deteriorated condition and is located on a tract containing 0.75 acre.</p>

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The area of significance of this house is its architecture. According to local historians, it is one of several houses constructed as company-owned dwellings by the paper mill which operated at Security from about 1865 to 1929.

The village of Fiddlersburg is said to have been named for a number of older men who lived in the community during the late 19th century and who played their fiddles on summer evenings.

Several dated examples of Washington County's 18th century stone dwellings are located in Security (WA-I-116, WA-I-124, WA-I-125).





