DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE	
<p>This house is located at the northwest corner of the intersection of Antietam Drive and Security Road about two miles east of Hagerstown in Washington County, Md. It faces south and east.</p> <p>The structure is a two-story, three-bay dwelling presumably of log construction and sheathed with turn-of-the-century period board siding. A one-story, four-bay el, also seemingly of log, extends to the rear or north. Its east elevation is coated with roughcast or stucco.</p> <p>The elevations of the front section are quite high. The windows appear to be spaced evenly in the front or south elevation. Six-over-six pane double-hung sashes are trimmed with turn-of-the-century period architraves. First story openings are substantially larger than those at the second story. Windows in the rear section are randomly spaced.</p> <p>The main entrance is located in the east bay of the south elevation. Door trim is similar to that of the windows. The framing holds a plain board door with no windows or transom. Two entrances are present in the east elevation of the el. Both are simple in appearance.</p> <p>Sheet metal and singles roof the main section. The roof extends beyond the end walls and terminates at the eaves with simple boxing. Roofing material at the rear section is corrugated sheet metal. Under the roof span of the rear el is a deep overhang supported by square posts. A brick chimney is located inside the west end wall of the main section. A large stone exterior chimney topped with brick extends from the north gable end of the el.</p> <p>The house is in fair conditon and is located on a lot 30' X 300'.</p>

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The area of significance of this house is its architecture. Constructed of log, it is representative of a major building tradition in Washington County and the Cumberland Valley. Log was used as a building material in Washington County from the earliest days of settlement to <sup>the</sup> late in the 19th Century. Many log structures are still in use today disguised by various forms of siding or bricks.

Several dated examples of Washington County's 18th century stone dwellings are located in Security (see forms WA-I-116, WA-I-124, WA-I-125).
