<p style="margin-bottom: 20px;">This house is located just south of Old Forge Road about one mile east of Fiddlersburg in Washington County, Md. It is situated on low ground and faces west.</p> <p style="margin-bottom: 20px;">The structure is a two-story four-bay stone and concrete block house which has been painted white. The upper story and the roof construction is recent. The first story consists of rubble fieldstone.</p> <p style="margin-bottom: 20px;">Windows in the stone section are relatively large and display narrow framing finished with a bead at its inside edge. The sashes are modern.</p> <p style="margin-bottom: 20px;">The main entrance is in the second bay from the north end of the house. It is simple in appearance although there is evidence of alteration of the size of the opening.</p> <p style="margin-bottom: 20px;">A one-story shed roofed porch extends along the west elevation. It is supported by square posts set in concrete.</p> <p style="margin-bottom: 20px;">The house is in good condition and stands on a tract containing 5 acres.</p>


