DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (If known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE	
<p>This house is located on the east side of Marsh Pike, just north of Lehman's Mill Road in Washington County, Maryland. It is situated on a slight slope and faces west.</p> <p>The structure is a one and a half story, two bay log cabin sheathed with pink shingle siding. The walls are set on roughly coursed fieldstone foundations which are relatively high at the front elevation.</p> <p>Windows are placed at random in the walls. Six over six pane double hung sashes are held within frames with wide facing.</p> <p>The main entrance is located in the northernmost bay of the front elevation. Its treatment is simple. The door and window in the front elevation are sheltered by a Victorian period porch supported by chamfered posts with decorative brackets.</p> <p>The roof is covered with sheet metal terminating at plain barge boards set directly against the end walls. A small brick flue is located inside the north gable end.</p> <p>The house is in fair to good condition and is located on a tract containing 89.87 acres. On the same farm is an early 20th century brick dwelling and a stucco covered stone dwelling described in survey form WA-I-212.</p>

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The area of significance of this dwelling is its architecture. Constructed of logs it is representative of a major type of vernacular architecture in Western Maryland and the Cumberland Valley. Log was used extensively as a building material in Washington County from the earliest days of settlement to well into the 19th century. Many log structures remain in use today, covered with various forms of siding or bricks.


