DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This farmstead is located at the end of a long private lane which extends in an easterly direction from McDade Road just north of Cedar Lawn and the U.S. Route 40 by-pass, west of Hagerstown in Washington County, Maryland. The main buildings in the complex are a frame house and barn both of which face south.

The house is a two story, two level frame structure sheathed with German siding, and said by the tenant to have been built about 1900. The higher, eastern part of the house is two bays wide. The west wing is narrower, lower in elevation and only one bay wide. A double porch extends across its front. Another wing is located to the rear and a one story shed roofed addition is attached to the east end wall.

The large frame bank barn is located west of the house. Behind the house are the remains of foundations which are said to have been an older stone house which burned. Part of the lane giving access may have at one time continued south to link with what is now Hopewell Road. Its earlier alignment has been disturbed by the new U.S. Route 40 by-pass.

The buildings appear to be in good condition. The farm property contains 167.67 acres.


