DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE	
<p>This cemetery is located on the east side of Mt. Lena Road, about one-half mile south of Jugtown Road in Washington County, Maryland. It is situated on high level ground at the base of the west slope of South Mountain.</p> <p>The cemetery contains a number of deteriorated stones dated from the second half of the 19th century. Many depict death dates within the decade of the 1880's. The names Wilson and Carl are to be seen on several tombstones.</p> <p>Local historians report that an African Methodist Episcopal church was located nearby.</p> <p>There is no record of ownership of the cemetery, however, deeds for the adjoining property refer to land owned by the African Methodist Episcopal Church of Crystal Falls (118/257). The Crystal Falls AME Church was mentioned as binding on the property immediately north of the cemetery as early as 1878 in a transaction from William J. Huyett to Harriet Harrison (76/548). Apparently the cemetery is located on part of the Huyett tract which contained several hundred acres in the area between Cavetown and Mt. Aetna.</p> <p>The cemetery is in deteriorated condition.</p>

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE			
<p style="text-align: center;">The AME cemetery is significant for its contribution to the religious and social history of Washington County. It is also important as a record of the history of black people of Washington County. According to local historians, Jugtown was a black community in post Civil War days. The name, Jugtown, however, had its origin during prohibition when moonshine was made in the area.</p>
