This house and agricultural complex is located at the end of a private lane leading in a southerly direction from U.S. Route 40, east of Maryland Route 63 at Huyetts Crossroads, west of Hagerstown in Washington County. It is situated on an area of level ground with the house facing north.

The dwelling is a two story, five bay brick structure with a two story, three bay wing extending to the rear. The date 1888 is said to be written in the attic. The walls are constructed in common bonding at all elevations with, generally, seven rows of stretchers between header courses. The header bricks are darker, forming a pattern in the walls. All windows have segmental arches at their heads topped with a double course of short bricks.

Openings appear to be arranged symmetrically in the walls. Windows have narrow casings which hold single pane, double hung sashes. Most windows retain pairs of louvered shutters. The main entrance is located in the center bay of the front elevation. It is framed similarly to the windows and has a transom with a segmentally arched head matching those of the windows. Evidence remains at the front elevation of a one story porch which apparently extended a/ ; most of the facade.

The roof is sheathed with asphalt shingles and extends beyond the end walls. A concrete block flue is located at the east gable end and a small brick chimney is located at the west end. A double porch is constructed along the east elevation of the wing.

Near the house are modern barns and agricultural buildings. The structures are in excellent condition and stand on a tract containing 126.35 acres.


