## DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This brick house is located on the east side of Maryland route 65, the Sharpsburg Pike just south of Waganan Road, south of Hagerstown in Washington County, Maryland. It is situated on an area of level ground and faces west.

The house is a two story, three bay building with a two story, three bay wing extending to the rear or east. The wing had a recessed double porch along its east elevation which has been enclosed in recent years. The entire structure rests on fieldstone foundations and would appear to have been built at one time. The surface of the building has been sand blasted.

Flemish bond brick work was used at the front elevation while American or common bonding with five courses of stretchers between header rows was employed at the other elevations. Flat arches of brick are present above the windows of the two main stories. Several courses of brick are present between the tops of the second story windows and the eaves. Square protruding bricks form dentil-like projections along the top of the walls.

Windows are aligned with each other in the walls. They have narrow frames which hold nine over six pane sashes flanked by pairs of louvered shutters. The main entrance is located in the south end bay of the front or west elevation. Trimming the door is a modern colonial style scroll pediment. This entrance opens into a broad stair hall which features symmetrically molded door trim with decorated corner blocks. Original carpenter-type locks remain on doors observed from the hallway.

The roof of the house is sheathed with sheet metal and extends beyond the end walls. Large brick chimneys are located inside the end walls. Behind the house is a log outbuilding and a small brick structure, possibly a smoke house. The buildings are in excellent condition and stand on a lot containing 1.06 acres.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This brick house, three bays wide with a side hall entrance would appear to date from the latter part of the second quarter of the 19th century. According to the present owner, the building date is 1835. The general form of the house and its interior finish suggest a rather sophisticated builder. The house does, however, show such vernacular regional characteristics as the recessed double porch along an extension to the rear of the main block.




