DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This house is located north of Mt. Aetna Road, east of U. S. Route 40 in the Colonial Park subdivision southeast of Hagerstown. It stands on an area of level ground and faces west.

It is a two story, five bay structure with a deep overhanging two story porch supported by massive round two story columns. The building is completely sheathed with aluminum siding. It would appear to be entirely of frame construction. According to the present owner, the structure is a "Pre-Civil War" house. Extensive alterations and additions to the building make an assessment of its age without further examination difficult. The house is T-shaped with a two story, five bay wing extending to the east.

Six over six pane windows are used at the main story of the structure. Projecting from the west slope of the roof are three dormers with steeply pitched pedimented gables. The roof extends some distance beyond the end walls and is carried across the gables in the form of a pent. It is sheathed with slate.

The house has the outward appearance of dating from the early 20th century.




