DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This vacant and deteriorating log house is located on a large farm west of Edgewood Drive, north of Mt. Aetna Road and southeast of Hagerstown in Washington County, Maryland. It rests on low stone foundations and is completely sheathed with German siding. Windows are long and trimmed with plain flat topped architraves. No sashes remain. Small brick chimneys with corbels at their tops are located inside the end walls. A standing seam sheet metal roof is used. Exposed lath at the interior was sawn.

A small stone outkitchen with a batten door and batten shutters on its windows is located adjacent to the house.


