DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This house, a four bay, one and a half story log structure is located at the north edge of Mt. Aetna Road, between Edgewood Drive and White Hall Road southeast of Hagerstown in Washington County, Maryland. The building which stands on fieldstone foundations is completely sheathed with aluminum siding. It is a secondary dwelling on Melrose Manor, a farm which has a main building complex discussed in survey form WA-I-032. Very little of the original fabric of the building is apparent from its exterior.

Its door and window arrangement consists of two front entrances centered side by side in the front elevation. The half windows at the upper story of the front elevation are not aligned with the first story openings.

The age of this house cannot be determined without further examination.
