DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This house is located on the north side of Long Meadow Road, just east of Paramount, north-east of Hagerstown in Washington County, Maryland. It is situated on a slight slope of ground and faces south. A two story, five bay painted brick structure, the house rests on low field-stone foundations. A vertical seam in the wall suggests that the two western bays are an addition. In the upper west corner of the front wall of the older section is a date stone inscribed with the name Ann R. and the date Oct. 1868. It would appear that the addition was made a relatively short time thereafter. All walls display common or American bonding with numerous courses of stretchers between header rows. Flat arches are present above the openings.

Windows have narrow frames with six over six pane sashes. Various types of shutters are used, some with paneled and louvered combinations and some with movable louvers.

The principal entrance is located in the center bay of the older section. Another is located in the second bay from the west end of the addition. Each has a transom. The main entrance is sheltered by a one bay flat roofed entrance porch supported by square pillars and partially enclosed by a lattice work balustrade. It may be original. Another one story porch is located at the two bays of the addition.

The roof is sheathed with sheet metal and extends beyond the end walls. Chimneys are located inside the end walls of the main section and inside the end wall of the addition.

The house appears to be in good to excellent condition and stands on a lot containing 1.62 acres.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This brick house is dated 1868 and thus provides a record of its age. The name inscribed in the date stone is Ann R. which presumably refers to Ann Rowland. The farm on which this house was located was purchased by Jonas and Ann Rowland in 1837, (TT/100). By 1865 Jonas Rowland had died and the farm was purchased from his estate by his widow, (LBNI/121). She retained the property until 1874. The main buildings on the Rowland farm were located some distance to the north. See WA-I-234.


