DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This small house is located on a steep slope on the east side of the Antietam Creek and faces east. It is a one and a half story, three bay building which appears to be brick cased. A frame section extends to the rear. The front section has a deep overhanging roof which forms a porch along the east wall. The roof is sheathed with corrugated sheet metal and a brick chimney protrudes from the interior of the structure.

Without further examination the construction of this building cannot be discussed. It is possible, however, that its brick surface is a veneer over another material such as log.

The house is in deteriorated condition.




