DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This farmstead is located on the west side of Maryland Route 65, the Hagerstown-Sharpsburg Pike south of Hagerstown and north of Roxbury Road in Washington County. It is situated on an area of relatively level ground with the house and barn each facing east. The house is a two story, four bay brick building painted red. Wide wood lintels are prominent above six over six pane double hung sashes. Clustered between the house and barn are numerous sheds and outbuildings. The frame barn has metal ventilator cupolas extending from its roof ridge. The complex appears to be in excellent condition and is part of a farm containing 145 acres.
