The Ziegler-Martin House is a late nineteenth century frame house with a decorative pendant cornice and bargeboards. The two-story house has a one story porch with a small pediment over the entrance with an incised floral design. These decorative features are not common in this section of Washington County, perhaps due to the rather austere influence of Mennonite settlers.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Ziegler-Martin House is a late-nineteenth century, two-story frame house with decorative pendant cornice and bargeboards located on the southeast side of Leitersburg Road (MD. 60) and facing northwest.

The main elevation has irregular bay divisions with several apparent alterations. The original configuration may have been four bays. A one story porch extends across the facade, with the northern bays obscured by a polygonal bay occupying the north end of the porch. The porch roof has a small pediment over the entrance with an incised floral design.

The foundation of the house is stone and the exterior is German siding. The roof is corrugated metal. A scroll sawn pendant cornice and bargeboards at the gable ends of the house are the most important decorative details.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Ziegler-Martin House has fine decorative woodwork, a feature not commonly seen on late nineteenth century houses in this section of Washington County. The rather austere influence of Mennonite settlers may have precluded such architectural displays in other houses.

This house, or one it replaced is shown on the 1877 map of Washington County as that of "D. Zeigler", presumably the owner of the sawmill about 75 yards east of the house (see WA -I-47).




