These two similar frame houses, probably dating from the late 19th or early 20th century, are located among several other later houses at the end of a dirt road from the north side of Route 68 near Pinesburg. Each house is 2½ stories high and gable roofed, with a central cross gable on the principal facade. Both houses are three bays wide and have a central doorway.




