The frame house is a two-story, three-bay by two-bay house built in the L-shaped farmhouse style of the region. It has a gable roof of standing seam metal. The main facade has a full-length, one-story porch with a hipped roof. The northern gable end has an exterior-end brick chimney. The structure appears to date from the early 20th century.

The frame house is located on the east side of Rt. 65, at the intersection with Reichard Road. The property is across the road from Reichard and north of a dirt lane that leads to a farm on the side of Rt. 65. The main facade faces west.

The main facade has a three-bay first story with a central entrance. One-over-one sash windows are in the two bays on the first story and the second story. The second story windows have black and white aluminum awnings. The one-story porch has boxed posts supporting a hipped roof. The house is covered in modern aluminum siding. The northern gable end has a exterior end brick chimney that also appears to be a modern addition. On the north side of the ell is a rear entrance to the house.

There are no significant outbuildings on the property.


