Located at 109 E. Baltimore Street is this 2½ story, two bay shed-roofed house.

Exterior finishes are of recent vintage and include vinyl siding, parged foundations and replaced windows and sash. The door, door trim and entrance steps are also recent additions.

The overall form of the place suggests a turn-of-the-century construction date. It appears to have been built as infill on the lot shared by its neighbor to the east.


