Description:

This brick house is a two story, three bay structure with a central cross gable and a semi-hexagonal projecting bay at the west end of the first story. Windows and doors are located beneath segmental arches of brick. Windows have six over six sash which may be replacements. Across the front is a hipped roof porch which also forms the roof of the projecting bay. The porch is supported by turned posts and has turned and jig sawn trim. Similar trim embellishes the cross gable.

Probably built around 1890, this is a residential structure that reflects the waning of commercial activity on Baltimore Street as railroads siphoned traffic from the National Road. Heavy highway traffic did not return until the development and dominance of the automobile.


