Description:

Located on the south side of West Baltimore Street is this two story, five bay log house. It is covered with asbestos shingle siding and embellished with a central cross gable with fancy cutwork trim. While there are five bays across the second story, there are only four at the first story level with a semi-hexagonal projecting bay taking up part of the two eastern bays. The three western bays are more closely spaced toward the west end of the house. The main entrance is in the central bay, but is offset slightly to the west. A one story porch from the early 20th century extends across the front. The windows have two over two pane sash with arched topped panes. The building may have been constructed in two parts with the west three bays coming first.

According to the 1877 Atlas map for Funkstown, this was the property of W.S. Knode in that year.



