Description:

This is one of a group of three American Foursquare style houses on the south side of E. Maple Street. They were probably all built by the same person around 1910. This example is covered with aluminum siding. It is a two bay structure with a semi-hexagonal projecting bay and the entrance at the front elevation. The house has the characteristic hipped roof and a hip roofed dormer. Windows have single pane sash. A shed roofed porch extends across the front.

The three Foursquare houses at 101, 103 and 105 E. Maple Street reflect the late development of the side streets of Funkstown.


