Description:

The Funkstown Cemetery occupies almost an entire block bounded by West Side Avenue and Antietam, Cemetery and Green Streets. The oldest area of the cemetery is the east end where there are numerous stones with German inscriptions and death dates in the 18th or early 19th century. Most recent burials are located toward the west end of the cemetery. In the original town plan for Funkstown, two lots, numbers 138 and 139 were reserved for a church and cemetery. The church was never built on these lots, but the cemetery grew and expanded over several additional lots.


