Description:

Probably dating from the 1930s is this bungaloid house, a one story, three bay frame structure. It has been covered with vinyl siding. Windows are paired at the front with upper sashes with three vertical lights over single pane lower sashes. These windows were common in the 1930s. The entrance is in the center bay and is sheltered by a shed roofed porch which extends outward from the main roof.

Much of Funkstown's area of the main street was developed in the 20th century. This house reflects that pattern.


