Located on the southeast corner of Maple and Antietam Streets is this two story, three bay log house covered with German siding. Windows have two over two pane sash, within architraves with molded flat tops. The main entrance is located in the central bay. A shed roofed porch, supported by square posts extends across the door and flanking windows. A two story wing extends to the rear.

According to the 1877 Atlas map of Funkstown, this property belonged to A. McCoy.


