Description:

This two story, three bay vinyl sided log house is located on the southwest corner of Maple and Antietam Streets. Exterior elements and trims are of recent vintage. The main entrance is located in the central bay of the front elevation, but offset to the west against the west front window. A one story porch extends across the front. A house like this is almost impossible to date from observation of the exterior. The first story door and window placement which does not relate to that of the second story could suggest an early one-story house to which the second story was added.

According to the 1877 Atlas map for Funkstown, this house belonged to a Mrs. Riddle.


