Description:

Located on the south side of West Maple Street is this two story three bay house which appears to be a log structure with brick veneer. It has six over six windows and a central entrance without a transom. One character-defining feature is the Italianate influenced entrance porch supported by square posts with brackets. Visible portions of the house suggest a construction date during the third quarter of the 19th century.

The property is shown on the 1877 Atlas for Funkstown with the owner listed as E. Stouffer.


